SUBJECT: Radiator Cleaning Tips — 2007 YFM7FGPW, YFM7FGPHW (Grizzly 700)

INTRODUCTION

To allow the engine cooling system to work to its full potential, it is imperative to keep the radiator free from obstructions. In an effort to make this easier, the Grizzly 700 has been fitted with removable front grilles to allow for better cleaning access. Please share this information with your customers.

CAUTION:

Do not operate the unit with an air intake grille removed.

When cleaning mud/dirt from the radiator, it is recommended to use a garden hose working from the inside to the outside and from both the front and back until all blockage is removed and clean water passes through the entire radiator. Using a pressure washer may allow blockage at the center of the radiator cores to remain even through the radiator surface looks clean from both ends.

CAUTION:

A high pressure washer can damage the radiator fins.

Removal and Installation Procedure:

Perform the following procedure:

1. Remove the rivets (see photo below).



2. Remove an air intake grille (see photo).



3. Clean the radiator at the access area.



4. For installation, reverse the above procedure.
